This workshop covers the set-up and execution of various methods of ratchet pulls and wire work that are used in the motion picture industry. The workshop is designed for training professional stunt performers as well as novices who just want to experience the thrill of doing motion picture stunts.

This seminar will cover:

Set safety and etiquette
Intro to the various methods used to pull, launch and fly performers on film sets
Harnesses and swiss seats
Set-up procedures
The art of the illusion (*making the action look REAL*)
Working with camera angles
Terms and definitions of the stunt professional
Working with rigging, lines and cables
The high tech and low tech tools of the trade and when to use them
Lots of hands on experience.

The final exercise will be to choreograph, rehearse, and shoot an action scene and give the students a hands on experience with action film making.

All attendees will receive a certificate of completion and competency from Action P.A.C. Stunts, L.L.C.

This workshop involves dangerous, physically demanding activities and should only be undertaken by participants with the appropriate physical and mental capacity to handle them.
